We stopped and took that opportunity to present the gospel. One teen, Anna gave her testimony that she was saved. But her two friends said they were not saved and wanted to see how to be saved. We took the Bible and the Holy Spirit went to work. Both Tyesha and Kassia trusted Christ as their Saviour.

The following week, while out door knocking, I met a lady named Octavia. Octavia grew up as a Baptist and attended church most of her life. When I asked her if she would go to Heaven when she died, she said she did not know. I went through the scriptures with her. Octavia then knew where she would go when she died and it was not Heaven. She prayed to receive Christ that day. Please pray for her. She had been in a bad car accident and has a lot of physical problems.
