

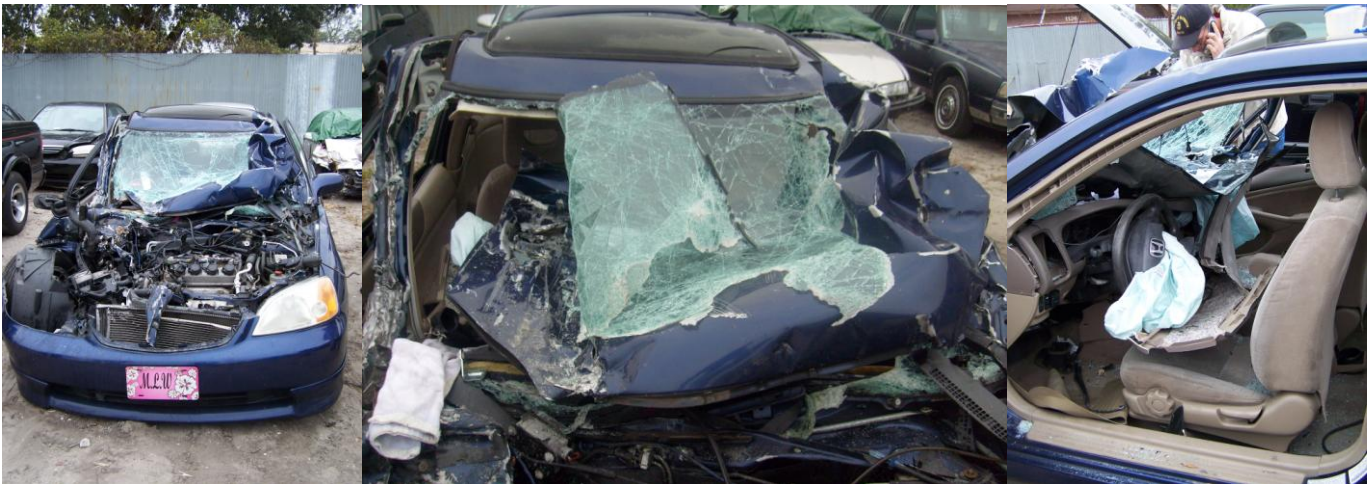

God continues to use our church to battle Satan. We see people saved almost every week. There is a new, young, married, Navy couple now coming to our church faithfully. Also, a young single sailor named Steven, who is very excited about our church. He is a year older than our son Donny, and they get along great. We have sailors and their families over to our house almost every Sunday for dinner so that they have a home away from home. The young sailor, Steven, said Sunday at lunch, "Boy it is sure good eating a home cooked meal."

Two weeks ago, Meghan, our daughter, was involved in a major car accident. Looking at her car, it is a miracle that she is alive. Her car was totaled but God has spared her life. Amazingly, Meghan only has a bunch of black and blues, cuts and scrapes, and both bones in her left forearm are broken. She had to spend six days in the hospital in ICU and had to have an operation to repair her arm, (they had to put in plates and screws). Meghan is a full time student and works at Chick-Fil- A part time. She has no health insurance and now has about 60 thousand dollars worth of medical bills and they continue to pile up. Because of her accident, she will be out of work for three weeks. We ask you to please pray for her recovery and pray that God will meet her financial needs.
